- The proposal should follow this format: introduction; purpose(s) or objective(s); citations/references/data sources and conclusion.
- Proposals can consist of more than one student sharing their work. (Multiple proposals may be presented).
- **Please limit your workshop or session to 1 hour**

Ideas to consider:

- Focuses on: leadership, community, educational and cultural issues, career development, technology, and current issues
- Emphasis on demonstration, audience participation as opposed to lecture and discussion.
- The conference theme should be included in your proposal.
- The participants desire engaging activities and interactive group learning opportunities.
- Allow time for questions and comments from the audience.
- **Please remember that all workshops must include a student presenter**
