The deadline for completed applications is January 31, 2012.

Please submit the following application materials:

- Application form
- CV or résumé
- A one-page statement detailing your qualifications for serving as an AI, your academic goals and your progress toward your degree
- **Two** letters of evaluation from faculty, addressing your potential for academic work and for teaching
- Evidence of the quality of your teaching, if you have previously taught in EALC or elsewhere: student evaluations, video, etc.

PLEASE NOTE:

- If you have previously applied for an AI position in EALC, previous application materials **cannot** be used. You must submit a new application form and a current statement and reference letters.
- All AIs whose native language is not English **must** take and pass the [Test of English Proficiency for International AI Candidates \(TEPAIC\)](http://www.indiana.edu/~dsls/publications/TEPAICsignup.htm), administered by the Department of Second Language Studies. Students who cannot pass the exam will **NOT** be allowed to teach. Please see the following website for more information on the exam:
