Postdoctoral position in Environmental Biogeochemistry

Applicants are sought for a postdoctoral position to begin spring 2010 in the Biogeochemical Laboratories at Indiana University - a collaborative research group centered in a new multidisciplinary research facility. The initial appointment is for 1 year, renewable with satisfactory performance.

We seek candidates with research experience in stable isotope biogeochemistry and/or microbial ecology or geomicrobiology and an interest in greenhouse gas cycling in wetland soils. Proficiency in the use of stable isotopes (C, N, H, and/or S) to study microbial processes is required. Knowledge of modern microbial techniques (PCR, light microscopy, environmental genomics) is desirable.
