Option 1: Complete and submit the application online at

Option 3: If you do not have access to the Web or have trouble accessing the proper forms, you can request an application be mailed to you by calling 1-800-765-7755 or by e-mailing speainfo@indiana.edu.

Application Checklist:

- **Application form** – submitted online or on paper
- One **official transcript** from each college attended (If you attended Indiana University, you need not submit a transcript: we can obtain it from the Registrar.)
- Three **letters of recommendation** – preferably from faculty members. If you are submitting a paper application, you can print out recommendation forms at http://www.iu.edu/~speaweb/admissions/ma_reform.pdf
- **GRE scores** (LSAT is acceptable if you are applying to the joint law program.) Our institution code is 1324, and our department codes are 2204 (MPA) and 0502 (MSES).
- **Residence Classification Form** (Only domestic applicants who are using a paper application need to complete this form.) <https://www.indiana.edu/~grdforms/deptforms/datasheet.pdf>
- **TOEFL** scores for international students (Our institution code is 1324 and our department code is 94.)
- **Statement of purpose** (The average length is two pages; you may combine the two essay questions into one statement.) On the electronic application, answer the “Departmental Questions” and leave the “Personal Statement” blank.
- **Résumé** or CV.
- **\$50 application fee** (\$60 for international students) The electronic application requires payment by credit card upon submission. The paper application requires payment by check or money order. Please write your birthdate, SSN, and degree program on your check and make it payable to Indiana University. Checks should be mailed to the University Graduate School, 130 S. Woodlawn, Kirkwood Hall 111, Bloomington, IN 47405.
- **Domestic applicants:** All paper materials (excluding checks) should be sent to the SPEA Graduate Program Office at the address located in the box below.
- **International applicants:** All paper materials should be sent to the Office of International Admissions, 300 North Jordan Avenue, Bloomington, IN 47405.
