Installation Instructions

This program is an annual lease. The expiration date is printed on the CD sleeve. If you wish to continue using the program after it expires, you will need to purchase a new CD, and install it.

System requirements

- Operating System
 - Mac OS® X 10.4 or higher
- Hardware
 - Intel® processor
 - 512MB RAM; 1GB recommended
 - Minimum 800 MB of available hard-disk space
 - Super VGA (800x600) or a higher-resolution monitor
 - CD-ROM Drive
- Software

- Safari 1.3.1 or higher, Firefox® 1.5 or higher, or Netscape® 7.2 or higher
- Java Standard Edition 5.0 (J2SE 5.0)

Installation

Log on to your computer with administrator privileges. Insert the CD-ROM into the drive, double-click on the *PASW Statistics Installer* icon and follow the instructions that appear on the screen. You might be prompted to type the administrator's name and password. After you provide the info, the PASW Statistics 17.0-InstallShield Wizard starts.

Be sure to select **single user license** as the license type.

You need to use the serial number and authorization code on the CD sleeve when installing or

reinstalling SPSS. You should therefore **keep the CD sleeve** or the serial number and authorization code in a safe place.

This CD can be installed on up to two computers that are used by a single user. Once SPSS has been installed and authorized twice, the authorization code is no longer valid and the CD cannot be used for further installations.
