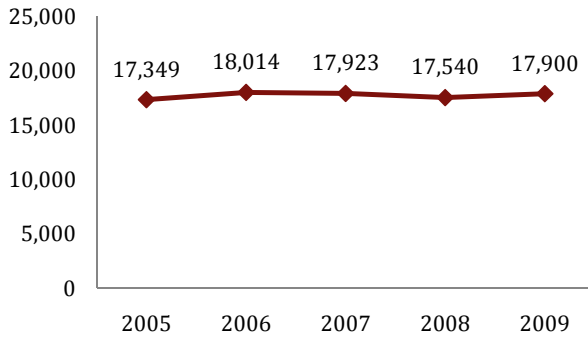

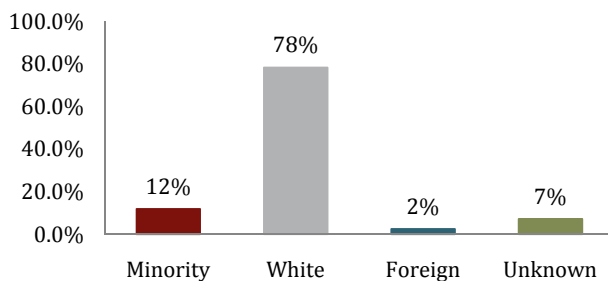

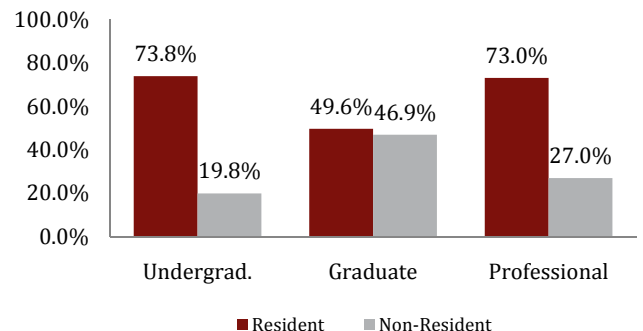

### Completions By Residency

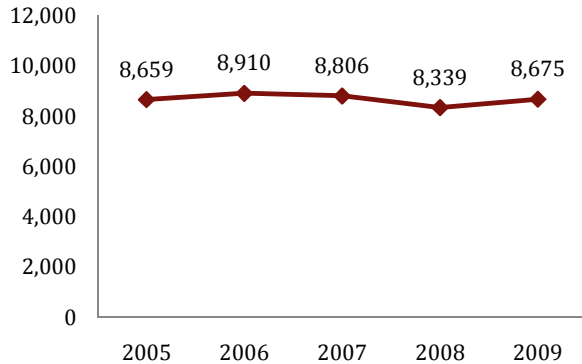

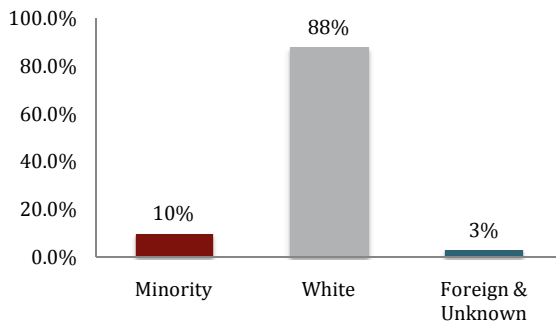

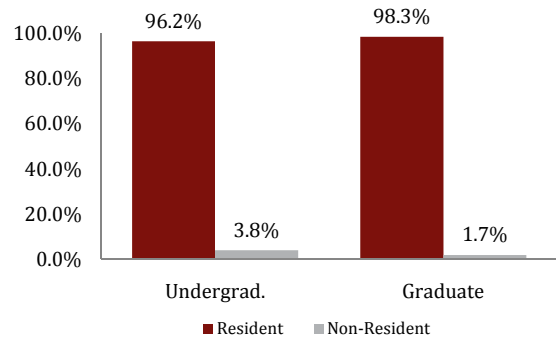
