

This brief report illustrates financial aid awarded to students who enrolled at time of census in any of the academic terms that comprise the fiscal year of 2008-09, who received a degree in the 2008-09 fiscal year, or who completed a correspondence course in the 2009-09 fiscal year. The financial aid figures represent disbursed aid<sup>1</sup> for the 2008-09 academic year and 2009 summer term (2008-09 "aid year"). All IU campuses are included other than Fort Wayne.

<sup>1</sup> Disbursed aid includes federal and state work study amounts paid through the IU labor ledger, including the employer's share and work-study program share, as well as gift aid and loan amounts disbursed in the IU Student Information System. Also included are several categories of aid that are recorded but not paid through the IU Student Information System. These categories include federal veterans educational benefits and IU athletic book scholarships. Students' aid amounts represent a snapshot of financial aid taken on September 14, 2009.

<sup>2</sup> All aid for students on a financial aid consortium agreement is reported on the student's home campus for that academic term.

<sup>3</sup> IUPU Columbus students and financial aid are included in the IUPUI figures. If students enrolled on both campuses, they are counted once in the figures above.

<sup>4</sup> Gift aid includes federal, state, institutional, and private scholarships, fellowships, grants, and fee remissions. Institutional scholarships and grants include fee courtesy and athletic aid. Also included are AmeriCorps educational benefits and educational benefits from the Veterans Administration.

<sup>5</sup> Loans include federal subsidized and unsubsidized loans, parent loans, private and institutional loans (excluding short-term emergency loans).

<sup>6</sup> Work study includes federal and state need-based work study earnings paid through the IU labor ledger.
